At 2:05P, 7-14-82, I assisted SGT. FORTUNE in Koehne Park. I took a total of seven black and white photographs of the orange Ford Pinto, that was left in Koehne Park by KEN FRANKS and two females whom he occupied the car with. I took one photograph of the overall scene, one photograph of the rear license number, one photograph of the drivers side of the vehicle, one photograph of the front of the vehicle, one photograph of the contents of the trunk, one photograph of the back seat area, and one photograph of the front seat area. I then dusted for fingerprints and I located several different prints on the car. I located three fingerprints on top of the roof on the passenger side of the vehicle. I located a thumb print on the front of the hood of the vehicle and I located a partial palm print on the roof of the drivers side of vehicle. I picked up all these prints and transferred them onto latent fingerprint cards so that they could be placed in the Special Locker as evidence. I also placed these photographs in the Special Locker as evidence, in reference to this case. I then filled out an inventory slip and called James Wrecker Service, and James Wrecker towed the vehicle to 1800 B LaSalle for safekeeping because of the fact that Koehne Park is not a safe place for anyone to leave a vehicle and we do not know what the whereabouts or circumstances are concerning the three missing people at this time.
