This officer received information that a Constable Goodwin of Moody, Texas, phone number 853-2844, had located the above vehicle on 7-31-82. I contacted him on 8-1-82 and met him at the Moody City limits at which he directed us at that time to where the vehicle was. I was with Officer Riddering. Officer Riddering attempted to take fingerprints off the vehicle but was unsuccessful in locating any. The vehicle was on the property belonging to a Margaret Cornelius, phone number 853-2990. It was at the intersection of her property and Whitlin Road in Moody. In talking to her she said that her son David had received a phone call at approximately 6:00 PM on 7-30-82 from a Terry Guterrez. He and his brother had stated to David that they had a vehicle which they needed David to take the motor out of that they did not have any registration for it and subjects who owned the vehicle wanted them to take the vehicle and he would report it stolen so that he could collect insurance on the vehicle. This again was at 6:00 PM on 7-30-82. David Cornelius had to go out of town that evening and left approximately 7:00 PM and has been out of town ever since.

On 7-31-82 the two Guterrez boys brought the car over to Ms. Cornelius' residence at about 4:30 PM. They came back several times doing things to the car but she did not pay much attention to what they were doing. At that time they were driving a brown Ford pickup with gold stripes down the side. Ms. Cornelius had gotten suspicious about the vehicle and called Constable Goodwin who came and checked in the vehicle and found it was stolen.

This story does conflict with the story given to this officer by Mr. Oliver on 7-31-82 in which he stated that he had the vehicle in his possession up until 9:00 PM on 7-30-82 and it was mysteriously stolen on Windmill Hill Drive after 9:30 PM. In talking to Mr. Goodwin and Ms. Cornelius they stated that a Joe Bob Guterrez who lives in Moody and is the cousin of the two Guterrez boys who are from Waco who had the vehicle had been bragging and commenting on Thursday afternoon about his two cousins had received this vehicle from a man who wanted to collect insurance on the stolen vehicle. This was on Thursday, 7-29-82. I have not been able to locate Mr. Joe Bob Guterrez or the other two Guterrez brothers who are suppose to live in Waco. I did not find anything on a Terry Guterrez or in our records and don't know what other brothers name is. I do not have an address on Joe Bob Guterrez who lives in Moody at this time.
