At 12:20P, 8-17-82, I tried to recontact a BARBARA HADLEY at 772-2206. This lady had given information earlier about a pickup that she had seen at Speegleville 2 or Speegleville 1 earlier the day of 7-13-82 however at this time when I called she had already changed her phone number and had changed it to an unlisted number. I did try the criss-cross and was unable to find her name in the criss-cross or address/phone number where she might be for a recontact of her personally.

At 1:10P, 8-17-82, I contacted a SHELLEY WHITE, another witness who had called before and I asked her if she had found out what RICK's last name might be where I can recontact him to find out who the guy was that he had talked to that was in a gray van the day afterwards which would have been on 7-14-82 in Koehne Park. I was informed by MISS WHITE that RICK had talked to the Subject and found that he was a salesman from Ft. Worth. Described the Subject as having brown hair, sort of curly and was small framed.

At 1:27P I contacted a SAM GARDNER, who is an ex-Captain with DPS, who stated to me that he does not know how the lady at the bridge party had gotten the information about his wife telling her about a pipe or bottle being inserted in the girl's vaginas when they were killed. He stated that he did not gossip about the thing and he knows that his wife did not do it either.

At 2:03P, 8-18-82, I was contacted by ROD MONTGOMERY of Waxahachie who is the father of JILL MONTGOMERY, the Victim, where he just wanted information to see if we had found out anything further, or have come any closer to finding who the killers were. He also wanted to know if we had done any checking on the story that had come through their City about two Mexicans in Ft. Worth talking about the murder and a Cuban subject entering the conversation and then referring the story to another lady from Waxahachie.

had talked to Det. LEWIS from the Waxahachie P.D. in reference to this information, where they told me that a subject by the name of ROBERT, who had worked at the EL CHICO Restaurant is the subject responsible for the murders. They brought me a picture down from Waxahachie which had a Mexican subject in it and JILL MONTGOMERY. The mexican subject was supposed to be the subject named ROBERT. We did go by the Methodist Home and found that the Mexican t

was with JILL was RICHARD LOPEZ and not ROBERT. Also checked the Restaurant and found that no ROBERT worked there what-so-ever in a long time.

I'd advise MR. MONTGOMERY that we were to be in his City sometime next week, to contact several witnesses that had given us information, contacting personally to check out their stories. He then told me that his sister-in-law, JAN THOMPSON, 937-2834, had told her about the story about the Mexicans in Ft. Worth. She will be contacted also, at such time that we do make a trip to Waxahachie.

At 9:05A 8-19-82 I contacted Sheriff's Office in MARLIN. I talked to MR. BEN KIRK in an effort to try to find a witness to our Murder's by the name of PATSY LYONS. Later Deputy KIRK did call back and advised me that PATSY could be contacted at the GRIDDLE DRIVE IN on VALLEY MILLS & PEIGHT. I did call 752-8599, where I did talk to PATSY & asked her to come into the Dept. to talk to me in person.

At 11:47A 8-19-82, I did make personal contact with PATSY LYONS, where I showed her an aerial photo of KOEHNE PARK, where she told me that she & a friend, TIM VESTAL, who works at INMAN MOTOR 5th & FRANKLIN, had been parked in the area of the boat ramp and that she felt like she had seen an orange car there at the boat ramp, further up from where they were parked, however she is not sure, because she does not know much about automobiles. I did show her a picture of the three Victims, where she was unable to say if she had seen these people in that area at all. She did state that there was nobody around the cars when she saw them, which was around 10:30PM and then came back at about 12:00 and stayed until about 3:AM in the morning at the boat ramp.

She then contacted TIM VESTAL at his place of employment, this AM, 8-20-82 at 8:42AM, where TIM did about the same thing, that he does remember seeing an orange car, but he does not know if it was a PINTO or not and that they had only been at the boat ramp and not at the 06, which is close up to the right of it. He did not hear anything out of the ordinary what-so-ever, during a long time that they were there.

At 8:45A 8-19-82, I re-contacted DEBBIE CUNNINGHAM and asked her if we could make personal

contact to show her a photo line-up to see if she might be able to recognize the subject that had been behind their pickup when they had been at the boat ramp around 11:PM 7-13-82. Did the photo line-up, which I had made up of six people, including photo #3 of WILLIAM KEITH PAYNE, who is now currently wanted for THEFT O/200 WARRANT #81408, which occurred on 8-1-82. After looking at the pictures, she stated that photo #3 with subject PAYNE, did look familiar, however she was unable to tell me for sure if this was the subject she had seen behind their truck. I did advise her at this time, that as soon as we did arrest this subject, new photographs would be made of the subject and also his brother, DAVID SCOTT PAYNE and that a new line-up would be shown to her.

At 9:15A 8-19-82, I did talk to a DANA SISEMORE, who is brother to DANNY SISEMORE, who is presently in Alabama. In talking to her, she told me that her brother was in Interprise, Alabama and was working as a Maintenance worker in a Hospital. During the conversation she stated that DANNY wanted to know what kind of weapon was used on BETH BRAMLETT when she was killed and then after that she said that there was a subject that he knew that hated both KEN FRANKS & BETH BRAMLETT by the name of DANNY McSPADDEN, who was a personal friend of DANNY SISEMORE. She said that DANNY had said that this McSPADDEN hated BETH because she had broken up with him and that he was very in love with her and hated KEN, because he, SISEMORE, had quit being friends with McSPADDEN and had started going around with KEN FRANKS. Information was given to me that McSPADDEN lived in a trailerhouse off of HWY 84, just before the ELK cut-off, that he worked at the CHEV. House Mart.

At 10:10A 8-19-82 I talked to a Sgt. MOORE of the Interprise, Alabama P.D. to check on SISEMORE of his whereabouts and if he was employed at the time of the murders here in Waco. I did call area code 205/347-1211. I later received information from Lt. HORTON that Sgt. MOORE had called back and stated that they had been unable to find SISEMORE, but that they had found that he had worked or was staying at the Apts. that we had mentioned previously and he had been there with the other subject. However have not found a place of employment for this subject as of this time.

At 11:40A I contacted DAVE MAYS, Editor of the BRYON EAGLE NEWS, in an effort to check out a story that had been put out by their paper about a LEIGHTON HURST, who had been released of a murder charge in Bryon, for multiple stabbing on his roommate. Needed to know this subjects whereabouts.

or how the story had gotten that LEIGHTON HURST was in Waco, going to TSTI. Again, MR. DAVE MAYS did call back later and talked to Lt. HORTON and stated that his information was that LEIGHTON HURST was presently in Austin, Texas and not Waco. Lt. HORTON then made contact with Austin P.D. where they are to send us fingerprint cards and a picture of LEIGHTON HURST, see if they could assist in our investigation.

At 2:23P 8-19-82, Det. Sgt. HOLSTEIN & I made contact with DANIEL JOSEPH McSPADDEN, Rt. 1, Box 169-V, AXTELL, DOB/2-8-63. DL#03895911. Residence phone: 863-5492. We interrogated this subject as to his knowledge of the triple murder and also his involvement with KEN FRANKS, who he stated he had not been very good friends with KEN FRANKS. He stated that he knew that KEN FRANKS smoked dope and that he didn't allow that in his apt. where he and DANNY SISEMORE were living at the NORTHWOOD APTS. on College Drive. He did state that last summer, that he and SISEMORE had been over to KEN FRANKS house, to look for him and that he was not at home when they had gotten there and MR. FRANKS had asked them to come inside. While they were there, MR. FRANKS had made a pass at both SISEMORE & McSPADDEN. After that they had left. McSPADDEN stated that he did not return to that house anymore. He stated that KEN FRANKS had stayed with them at the NORTHWOOD APTS for a couple days, last June, because KEN FRANKS could not go home for some reason or other, that he does not know for sure. He stated that he had seen a girl who was a brunette last summer, who was with KEN, however he does not know if it might have been BILL MONTGOMERY or not. He stated that the reason he did not like KEN was because he was a raggart and lied a lot.

He did ask him also, in reference to the killing of BETH BRAMLETT, which is being investigated by the Sheriff's Officers of McLennan County and he stated that he was not at the Lake party tonight that a fight had broken out and shots had been fired. That he had been with a SHELLY PRINGFIELD, MEXIA, Phone: 562-5807, and that he had gotten home about 10:45PM and did not go to the lake at all, which was on August 7, 1982. He stated that he had been BETH BRAMLETT's boyfriend and before he got out of high school in 81, however they had broken up because BETH did not like him anymore.

On this date, 8-20-82, made contact with MRS. VIRGINIA SINGLETON, at Turner's Grocery Store in

Axtell, where we asked her where we could find DANNY MCGINNIS and also her son, PERRY SINGLETON who might could give us some information on the whereabouts of some of these subjects. She then gave us directions to her house, where at approx. 11:10AM Sgt. HOLSTEIN & I did make personal contact with PERRY SINGLETON at Rt.1, Box 610, AXTELL, Phone: 863-5363. Subject is a W/M, DOB: 11-14-65. He stated to me that he did not know anything about the KEN FRANKS & the two girls murders at KOEHNE PARK, that he has never been there and that he has never heard DANNY MCGINNIS who is a good friend of his, to talk anything about it, other than that he knew KEN FRANKS really well. We then asked him also about the BETH BRAMLETT murder in AXTELL, where he said he had been at the party and had been there all night, however he had fallen asleep sometime after the fight. He had heard only that some people had fired some shots and that BETH BRAMLETT, ROBERT WATTS & another subject had ran off into the woods and that later one of the subjects, known now as ISSAC OCHOA, from EVANT, TEXAS had come back later and made peace with the subject that was holding the gun, which is known to be JOHN ROBINSON. He did give us directions of where to find DANNY MCGINNIS in Bellmead.

We did contact DANNY MCGINNIS at the LEGGETT LIVESTOCK AUCTION on Hwy 6, at approx. 12:10PM this date, 8-20-82. He told us that he had not seen KEN FRANKS in about two to three months, or about a month before he was killed. That he had seen him at KOEHNE PARK while they were swimming. He had not talked very much, only that he appeared to be happy, that he had a new motorcycle and it was paid for and that he was glad to be away from the Home. MCGINNIS stated that he had not been at KOEHNE on July 13, 82. He did give us some information into the BRAMLETT murder, which a suspect that had been run on Polygraph by the Sheriff's Office, by the name of ROBERT WATTS, that they had seen him this past Friday, which is on 8-13-82, in a Movie and that the subject appeared to be wearing a belt belonging to the deceased girl, BRAMLETT. This information was passed on to the Sheriff's Office as soon as it was obtained.

At approx. 2:30P I made contact with the Waxahachie P.D. where I talked to Capt. SULLINS and also Det. LEWIS to ascertain if they had had any further information on a name that I had submitted to them of a subject living in their City by the name of MIKE LAMAR, who had brought a girl from Waxahachie by name of DONNA MEDFORD and attempted to Rape her here. Det. LEWIS stated to me that they had been unable to find ZANE WOODARD, who was the subject who had passed the information to

On 8-11-82 at 12:58PM I did have an interview with a DRURY LEE SINGLETON of Rt. 1 Box 610, Axtell, home ph. 863-5361. DRURY SINGLETON was a witness for informant in reference to Murder that is being handled by the sheriffs office on a girl by the name of BRAMLETT. During their investigation, the name of ROBERT LEE WATTS W/M 11-21-63 had been brought up that he had knowledge of the Murder being handled by the Sheriffs office and also knowledge of the triple Murder that had happened in our city. After interviewing SINGLETON I found him to be a white male, dob/6-14-56, 5'8, 135, bro hair, found him to also be a homosexual who had given a home to ROBERT WATTS after he had come passing through our city possibly on July the 12th or the July 15th. SINGLETON mentioned that when he had picked them up hitchhiking on Hwy 84 just passed Bellmead that WATTS had made a mention about the triple Murder and also that he had spent the night at Ft. Fisher the night before the morning that he had picked him up and that a car similiar to the one involved belonging to the Murdered kids which being a orange vehicle had tried to pick him up that night and that he had refused to go with them being that he did not know them. Later they had wind up dead and that WATTS had the comment that had he gone with the group that he would probabl be dead himself.

After the interview with SINGLETON, I did interview ROBERT WATTS where he mentioned to me that he had left Belton Texas on Saturday July the 10th and had took him two days to get to Waco and that he was picked up by SINGLETON on Monday July the 12th in the morning. He stated that he was here in Waco when the Murders had occurred and this is how he knew about the Murders. This story differents from SINGLETON saying that he picked up WATTS on the 15th which is on a Thursday morning, two days after the Murder.

LT. GILBREATH of the Sheriffs Office has scheduled ROBERT LEE WATTS for a polygraph test on the BRAMLETT Murder handled by their office where he will be questioned also in reference to our triple Murder being that the polygraph test is scheduled to be run by our Sgt. SHERRE of the Waco Police Dept.

On 8-13-82 Ranger BOB PRINCE and MYSELF travelled to Ft. Worth where we talked to a LARRY KEITH ROBINSON W/M dob/8-12-57 who had been arrested on the five Murders in Ft. Worth last
