

NOTICE: This Request for Notice is not intended to waive in any way defendant's rights under his motions presently pending before the U.S. District Court and before the United States Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals concerning the Attorney Client Privilege/Work Product Materials illegally seized by the government including, but not limited to, reports, memoranda and internal defense documents made by the defendant at the direction of his attorneys or by his attorneys or agents made in connection with the investigation or defense of this case or of statements made by the defendant, or by government or defense witnesses or prospective government or defense witnesses to the defendant, VIC FEAZELL, or his attorneys or agents under the 6th Amendment to the United States Constitution and F.R.C.P. 16(b)(2).

MR. FEAZELL further requests that you, the said JAN PATTERSON, advise the undersigned counsel by letter within ten (10) days hereafter as to whether you will refuse to comply with the above request in order that there will be ample time prior to the trial herein to present any such refusal to the Court.
