- #1 - a 1970 green Cadillac which was purchased from Spencer's Car lot in Jacksonville, Florida in 1978 or 1979.
- #2 - a 1970 to 1971 Chrysler New Yorker, white in color, which was also purchased from Spencer's Car Lot on or about 1978 or 1979.
- #3 - a 1965 Chevrolet Impala, medium green in color, which was purchased from some unknown individual in Jacksonville, Florida in 1978 or 1979 and junked in Jacksonville, FL.
- #4 - a 1969 Cadillac, black vinyl over gold, which was purchased from Spencer's Car Lot in 1980 and kept for approximately one month.
- #5 - a 1965 Plymouth station wagon, blue in color, purchased out of state, possibly in Washington in 1979; this vehicle kept for approximately two months and sold to an unknown individual in Jacksonville, Florida.
- #6 - a 1973 Cadillac, black vinyl over white, purchased from Reeves Auto Sales in Jacksonville Florida during 1980 or 1981, which was kept for approximately seven months and given back to Reeves Auto Sales.
- #7 - a 1972 Dodge, brown and white in color, purchased from Spencer's Auto Service in Jacksonville, FL in 1978 which was kept approximately six months.
- #8 - a 1973 Chevrolet Impala station wagon, dark green in color, purchased from Spencer's Car Lot in Jacksonville, FL in 1981 or 1982 which was kept for approximately four to five months and was sold to a brother of Ottis Toole.
- #9 - a 1973 Ford LTD Country Squire station wagon, light blue in color, with wood grain striping, purchased in 1981 from a dealership in Washington State and later sold to Henry Lucas' step-father.
- #10- a 1973 Oldsmobile Vista Cruiser, blue and white in color, purchased in 1980 or 1981 which was kept for approximately one year and sold somewhere in Texas, possibly Delrio.
- #11- a 1973 Chevrolet pick-up, green and white in color, purchased from Spencer's Auto Sales in Jacksonville, FL. in 1980 or 1981 which was kept approximately one to 1½ years; this vehicle was returned back to Spencer's Auto Sales.
- #12- a 1973 Ford pick-up truck, green in color, which was later painted brown, purchased from an unknown individual in 1980 or 1981 which was kept for approximately one year and sold to an unidentified black female in the Jacksonville area.
- #13- a 1973 Cadillac, off brown in color, purchased from Rocket Motors in Jacksonville, FL. in 1981 which was kept for approximately two weeks and returned to Rocket Motors.
- #14- a 1972 Plymouth, white in color, purchased from Rocket Motors in 1981 and kept for approximately two months and was returned to Rocket Motors.
- #15- a 1973 Ford LTD Sedan, 4/door, brown in color, purchased from Spencer's Auto Sales in Jacksonville, FL. in 1981 and kept for approximately one month and sold somewhere in Texas.
- #16- a 1968 grey Cadillac which was bought from an unknown individual in 1980 or 1981 and kept for approximately 1½ years.
- #17- a 1970 Cadillac, dark green in color, no other information available.
- #18- a 1973 Cadillac, white and red in color, no other information available.
