Dear Sir:

On March 28, 1983 Dennis Lukich personally submitted a shirt (Item 1A) in connection to the above captioned case.

On March 28, 1983 you personally submitted the following additional evidence removed from a gold 1970 Malibu (Texas YTZ891, April 1983, VIN illegible) during examination of the vehicle by the laboratory. (See attached list).

On April 1, 1983 after further examination of the above vehicle by you and the laboratory, you personally submitted the attached list of items removed from the vehicle.

You requested examinations to determine the presence, origin, and type of blood found on the items submitted. You also requested that any hair found on the submitted items be collected.

We have completed our examinations and wish to report that no blood was detected on the shirt, Item 1A. Preliminary tests indicated the presence of blood on the passenger armrest (Item 1B) however the sample did not respond to testing to determine the origin. Human blood was detected on the carpet near the passenger door, (Item 3B) and on the front passenger seatbelt (Item 43) however the blood type could not be determined.

Hair was recovered from the items listed on the attached list. This evidence was returned to you on April 6, 1983

Should this case be disposed of without our appearance, please advise the disposition in order that our files may be complete.
