In March 2015 the Victim Services Division notified you that the offender named above had applied for consideration for a Conditional Pardon through the Executive Clemency Office of the Texas Board of Pardons and Paroles.

This is to inform you that the Board has voted not to recommend a Conditional Pardon for offender Melendez. The Victim Services Division will notify you if the offender reapplies for clemency, provided we have your correct address. On May 20, 2013 the Board denied parole and set the next review date for May 2016. Per Board policy, the offender will enter the parole review process four months prior to that date, in January 2016.
