DA Vic Feazell To Prosecute First Case

District Attorney Vic Feazell will handle his first criminal trial as chief prosecutor for the county Wednesday morning in

54th District Court.

Feazell, elected Nov. 2, as District Attorney, pledged during his campaign to be active in the courtroom as opposed to then DA Felipe Reyna.

Feazell and Lynn Kendrick, district attorney assistant, will represent the state in the David Wayne Spence, aggravated sexual abuse trial scheduled to begin at 10:30 a.m. in 54th District Court.

Court appointed attorney representing Spence is Walter Reaves.

The offense with which Spence is charged allegedly occurred on September 6, 1982. He was indicted by the grand jury on September 21 and arrested by McLennan County Sheriff's office on September 22.

He is still in McLennan County jail.
