I believe it was in November of 1978, I was traveling in Texas with Henry Lee Lucas. One night we were on an Interstate highway somewhere near Austin, when we picked up a boy and girl who were hitch hiking after having some kind of car trouble. He took them off on a little country road just off of the interstate highway. I got out of the car with the boy, and Henry stayed in the car with the girl. I had a .22 automatic pistol in my belt. I had sex with the boy - he put his dick in my mouth. (The boy and girl were about 18 to 20 years old. I have signed the back of the boys and girls pictures because I recognize them as being the ones we picked up. I shot the boy and he tried to run - then he fell. I went close to him and shot him again to make sure he was dead. I shot him many times and then took his billfold out of his back pocket. I got in the car with Henry and the girl and we went back to the interstate. Sometime later we stopped on the interstate, after the girl started raising hell and trying to jump out of the car, Henry shot the girl several times and left her alongside the interstate. We went down the road quite a piece. I don't remember what town we stopped at next. I don't read very well, but I have had this statement read back to me before I signed it. It was read back to me by Officer Ray Hardison, and it is true and correct.

Previously and when we stopped, Ottis had anal sex with the boy. He untied him and he started to run and Ottis shot him down. We had a .25 and .22 cal auto-matic and I'm not positive which one was used. After the boy was shot down and lying face down in the ditch, Ottis went thru his pockets and got some money and took his wallet out and then shot him some more. Me and Frank was holding the girl and Bechy was holding the door so she couldn't get out.

We left there and drove on up I-35 about 60 miles, took an off ramp, went by an overpass and I shot the girl on the access road. I shot her out the window & remember that she had something in her hands, I don't remember.
