At 2:30 PM, 7-26-82, I went to the house located across from HKB and contacted Ronald Wayne Robinson who lives at 1017 Morrow, phone number 756-5244. Robinson informed me that he and a friend of his by the name of John Kent who lives at 525 N. 9th were at Oaky Dokey Nightclub at Valley Mills and Wooded Acres on 7-13-82. He stated that they had been with a female subject that had been extremely intoxicated and that they had all left the club at 11:45 PM and drove to Kohne Park to try to sober up the girl. Robinson stated that they were in his friends car which is a 1970 blue Plymouth Duster with a white stripe down the side with Louisiana license plates, #245G748. Robinson stated that after they got down to Koehne Park and tried to revive the female subject that he and Kent both noticed the orange Pinto setting in the circle at Koehne Park. He stated that shortly after they had gotten there he saw another blue Plymouth Duster come into the parking lot and spin its tires off in the circle and leave. He stated that he did not see any other people down in Koehne Park at that time. He then informed me that a black Lincoln Continental pulled up next to Kent's car and that a white male subject who was driving the car described as having curly hair with an English pea cap, a sparse mustache and sideburns, asked Kent if he had seen a Monte Carlo with a blonde driving it. Kent informed the unknown male subject that he did not see anyone fitting that description and the subject drove the Lincoln Continental then proceeded to give Kent his home phone number and told him that whenever he and his friends wanted to party to go to his house and they would have a good time.

Robinson stated that the white male subject in the Continental had stated that he was smoking marijuana and hash. Robinson described the Lincoln Continental as being a newer model black Lincoln with a t-top or sun roof on it. Robinson then informed me that the person driving the car seemed to fit the description of a person that he had known while he was going to school Tennyson Junior High a few years ago and he stated that he believed that the subject in the Lincoln was someone that he knew by the name of Mr. Frueh. Robinson stated that he had heard Tennyson Junior High School that Mr. Frueh was a homosexual.

Robinson stated that he did not know of anything else that might possibly help us that he had seen that night because he too was highly intoxicated and that was all that he could remember about the evening.

Myself, Detective Salinas and Sgt. Fortune had already traced down the phone number given to

Police Sergeant WINKLER was contacted by a RONALD WAYNE ROBINSON of 1017 Morrow, phone 756-52 who stated to him over the telephone that he, ROBINSON, had seen a black Lincoln Continental at approximately 1:00 or 1:30 A.M., on Wednesday morning of 7-14-62 at KOEHN PARK. He states that this car was suspicious to him, being that shortly before, he had seen the orange Pinto coming into the Circle at KOEHN PARK, and a subject getting out of it, and a few minutes later a green Duster which was jacked up in the back with white tires, had come burning into the Circle, picked up the subject that had driven the orange Pinto in, and left. Approximately two to three minutes later, the black Lincoln Continental comes in and parks near where the orange Pinto is. He stated that at this time that he had been trying to advise the girlfriend that was with him in the car, being that she was intoxicated, and this subject had come and talked to him, and had given him his name and a phone number where he could call him later. The call ROBINSON, stated that the white male in the Continental appeared to be stoned, and was smoking MARIJUANA while he was talking to him. He stated that he knew what the subject was smoking, because he had been around it before. He thought that this was kind of suspicious, for a Lincoln to come in there after this car had picked up another subject, and then leave shortly after that himself.

Sgt. WINKLER did run the phone number down through the crisscross, and found it to be registered to a ROBERT FRENCH who is a reverend at a Baptist Church at 26th & Mitchell.
