At 12:20P, 7-16-82, I received information from J.P. JOE JOHNSON concerning further results of the autopsies of the three victims in this case.

The autopsy revealed that the weapon used was a knife with an approximate length of five inches the blade one-half inch in width, the blade thickness approximately one-sixteenth of an inch and the knife blade was single edged.

Neither of the white females was pregnant.

The pathologists in Dallas estimate that the time of death was between 9:P and 12 midnight on 7-13-82.

The great vessels in the necks of all three victims had not been severed.

The pathologists were not able to determine if the wounds to the victims were inflicted while the victims were standing or lying. However, all the wounds on the MONTGOMERY girl and the FRANKS boy were vertical.

Some of the wounds to the RICE girl were not exactly vertical but varied between 10 and 15 degrees up and down.

All the knots used to bind the victims were tied with granny knots.

There were no bruises on any of the victims.

The official cause of the death to all three victims were knife wounds to the heart.

At approx. 1:15P, 7-16-82, DR. STONE, who is a medical examiner from Dallas County, called in regards to the autopsy of our three murder victims. DR. STONE advised that both female victims had internal injuries to the vagina. DR. STONE advised that these injuries appear to have been caused by a bottle or some other smooth instrument.

DR. STONE said that the injuries could have been caused by repeated rapes of both victims, however no sperm was found and no seminal fluids were found. DR. STONE said that if repeated rapes were involved then the male Suspects would have had to use condoms.

DR. GILLILAND who is a pathologist with Dallas County advised that she believes that JILL MONTGOMERY's throat was cut when she was still alive.

DR. STONE left a business number of (214) 638-9980 and a residential phone number of (214) 233-1505. He advised that he will be at home this weekend and if OFFICERS need to, they can talk to him at his residence.

At approx. 1:30P, this date, I went to the FIGGLY WIGGLY store at 1711 Herring and talked to JOYCE BREITEN who lives at 2017 Bosque and has no home phone number. MS. BREITEN was the cash on duty at the FIGGLY WIGGLY store on 7-13-82. I showed MS. BREITEN a photograph of JILL MONTGOMERY and RAYLENE RICE and MS. BREITEN that both these Subjects came in to the store at approx 5:P, 7-13-82 and that at that time, JILL MONTGOMERY cashed a City of Waco payroll check at the store. MS. BREITEN also advised that RAYLENE RICE had cashed some type of payroll check but she could not remember which company or what amount the check was for.

MR. BREITEN that the two girls were by themselves and she could not remember what type clothing they had on.
