At 6:45P/7-14-82, Officers received call of Questionable Death at Speegleville, Area 3, located on the north side of the lake. Officers met Sheriff Office Personnel at Speegleville, who let us into a wooded area in Speegleville #3 near the waters edge, where upon we discovered the body of KENNETH FRANKS, lying next to the dirt road. Later was discovered the other two victims, RAYLENE RICE & JILL MONTGOMERY. Officers secured the crime scene, Personnel from the Lake Rangers blocked off dirt roads leading into the scene, preventing unauthorized Personnel to enter into the crime scene. The only physical evidence found at the scene were two empty cans of budweiser beer. They were found on the dirt road near the two female victims, RAYLENE RICE & JILL MONTGOMERY. These two cans of beer, were found at an opening to the wooded area from the road, through which the suspects may have dragged the victims. It appeared that the victims were slain at another location and brought to the wooded area & left. These two cans of beer were dusted by OFFICER WILCOX and has been tagged as evidence & placed in the property room.

I spoke with two citizens, JOSEPH CHAMBERS, 2400 Parrott, Waco, 755-6850 and to STANLEY SMITH, 2400 Parrott; Waco, 755-6850. These two subjects were fishing at Lake Waco in Speegleville 3. They found the body of KENNETH FRANKS lying beside the dirt road while they were traveling in their 69 Ford red over white P/U. After find this body at 6:15P/7-14-82, they notified Sheriff Office Personnel who came to the scene, who in turn, notified the Waco Police Department. Neither one of these subjects could give me a business address.
