At 10:58 AM, 7-20-82, myself and Texas Ranger Joe Wiley went to Whataburger on Lake Air Drive to see if we could possibly locate any of the employees at that location that might have seen Kenneth Franks go to their place of business on Tuesday, July 13th. We showed photographs to several of the employees at Whataburger however none of these people could remember whether or not Kenneth Franks had come into their place of business or not. They had stated that there was a subject that worked at Whataburger by the name of Mike Levy who also worked parttime at the Seven Eleven Store at 19th & Lake Shore who knows Kenneth Franks and probably would know whether or not he came in on Tuesday night, 7-13-82. I asked them if they had any address or phone on Mike Levy and they stated that they did not but that I could probably find him at the Seven Eleven at 19th & Lake Shore.

At 11:05 AM, 7-20-82, we went to Jack-In-The-Box at Wooded Acres and Bosque and showed the photograph to several of the people at that location also. None of these people could remember Kenneth Franks or the other two female subjects coming into their place of business on 7-13-82.

At 11:15 AM, 7-20-82, we went to the Army Recruiters Office in the Parkdale Shopping Center in an effort to locate Patty Deis. We found at this time that Patty was working at the Army Recruiters Office located on 5th Street across from the Citizens National Bank in downtown Waco.

At 11:32 AM, 7-20-82, we went to 19th & Lake Shore at the Seven Eleven in an effort to locate Mike Levy. We found out that Levy had not been to work at that location as he was not scheduled to work there and that he was scheduled to work again on 7-21-82.

At 12:45 PM, 7-20-82, myself and Ranger Wiley went to 117 S. 5th at the Army Recruiters Office and contacted Sgt. Flores who is the supervisor over Patty Deis at that location. Flores informed us that Patty had not been in to work on this date and that she was living in the Northwood Apts, Apt #218, and that we may be able to find her at home. He stated that Patty had been very upset since the killings and that 7-20-82 had been her second day of missing work since this incident occurred. He stated that she had also missed 7-15-82 when she had found out that Kenneth Franks had been murdered.

At 1:37 PM, 7-20-82, myself and Ranger Wiley went to 1500 College Drive, Apt #218, in an effort

to contact Patty Deis. When we arrived we noticed that the front living room window of the apartment had been busted into and that there was glass all over the outside of the window and we noticed that there was blood that had dripped down on to the sidewalk on the bottom row of apartments directly underneath the window. We knocked on the door to see if Patty Deis was home however we were unable to get an answer at the door. Myself and Ranger Wiley then went to the managers office at the Northwood Apts and he came back to Patty Deis' apartment with us and let us into the apartment to make sure that she was all right. Once inside the apartment myself and Ranger Wiley searched the interior to make sure that Patty Deis was not on the inside of th apartment and after finding out that she was not there we left the apartment. I then called Sgt. Fortune on a neighbor's phone by the name of Vivian Hoffman of 1500 College Drive, Apt #21 Sgt. Fortune informed me that Patty Deis was all ready at the Waco Police Department with Gayl Kelley in an effort to report the incident that had occurred at Deis' apartment. Myself and Ranger Wiley then returned to the Waco Police Department so that we could talk to these two subjects. Ranger Wiley talked to Patty Deis and I talked to Gayle Kelley after arriving at the Waco Police Department. Gayle Kelley informed me that Wilson Walker was a very good friend of Ken's and that he may be able to assist us in this investigation. She also stated that Henry Johnson of 900 West Sierra Madre, Apt #161, Azusa, California, phone number 213/969-9083, was also a good friend of Kenneth Franks and that he had come down to Waco for Franks' funeral. Gayle Kelley informed me that Kenneth and she had stayed out approximately three different times all night at either Patty's apartment or at the Lake and that Kenneth had never gone home on these occasions when he did this. She also informed me that Kenneth and his father had a large strain on their relationship because of the fact that Kenneth found out that his father was gay. She also stated that Kenneth Franks and Kenneth King did not get along at all and that both Kenneth King and Richard Franks were very heavy drinkers. She informed me that on 7-14-82 Mr. Franks had called Gayle Kelley and when discussing the fact that Kenneth might be missing and that something might have happened to him Mr. Franks had made the comment that he hoped that Kenneth did not get what he deserved. Gayle Kelley said that Mr. Franks said this very sarcastically and that she did not understand what he meant by this remark. She informed me that Kenneth had told her that Mr. Franks had sold his boat approximately three weeks ago and that Kenneth was an avid water skier. She also informed me that Kenneth King did not get along with Kenneth Franks' friends and whenever his friends would come over he would go upstairs

and never come down. Ms. Kelley informed me that Rebecca Desmarias had several dealings with narcotics and that Rebecca had sold several different narcotics at Waco High School on several different occasions. Kenneth Franks had made the comment to Gayle Kelley that they would be coming into a lot of money soon because of the fact that Kenneth had begun a partnership with a subject who he referred to as a new dealer and that he did not wish to give the new dealers name because of her safety. Gayle Kelley tried to get the name from Kenneth Franks however Franks' only comment was that Gayle Kelley knew who the subject was however he did not want to name him and that he was a dealer who had left Waco and had come back recently. I asked Gayle Kelley if she could remember anyone that had left Waco and had come back recently who deals in dope and she stated that she knew of three subjects that might possibly fit into this category. The number one subject was a subject by the name of Transky who she stated had gone to the penitentiary for narcotics and who had gotten paroled from the penitentiary approximately one year ago. She stated that the second subject was a subject by the name of Tab Harper who Ken had stated that he liked to party with because Harper had always gotten ahold of good narcotic. She stated that the third male subject was a subject by the name of Joey who was a redheaded male subject 19yos, from Dallas. She stated that he had come to Waco on one occasion approximately four months ago and he had brought a lot of narcotics with him. She stated that there was a large contraband of narcotics and a large amount of money passed around in Koehne Park when Joey had come to Waco and that he had told Ken that the next time he would come to Waco that he would look Ken up. She also informed me that Kenneth Franks did not get along with any of the motorcyclists in Koehne Park and that on several different occasions he had gotten into trouble with the motorcyclists. She stated that the only time that he did any dealing with the motorcyclists is when he was trading narcotics with Rebecca Desmarias and that he would not have any dealings with the rest of the motorcyclists at all.

On 7-21-82 I talked to Donna Olson. Donna Olson informed me that she had gone to the funeral of Kenneth Franks with a subject by the name of John Ashley. She told me that she had asked Mr. Franks where the bodies had been found and that he had informed her that he did not know. She then stated that Ashley had asked Mr. Franks the same question approximately 20 minutes later and that Mr. Franks had given directions to Ashley on where the bodies were found and that Ashley had made the comment that he had camped at that location at one time or another.

Mr. Franks had then replied that he too had camped at that location in the past.

On 7-22-82 myself and Sheriff Deputy Abner talked with a subject by the name of Clarence Pierce 27yoa, from Mt. Calm, Texas. Pierce informed us that he was in Speegleville Park on Tuesday night, 7-13-82, and that he had gotten to the park between 8:00 PM and 8:30 PM. He stated that he had stopped on the side of the road to help two white male subjects change a flat tire and that the two white male subjects had been driving at Datsun B210. He stated that one of the white male subjects he believed the name to be Bill and that the other white male subject was blonde headed and approximately 25yoa, muscular build, clean cut. He stated that after he helped these two subjects change the flat tire that they invited him to a party in Speegleville and that he had went ahead and went to the party with them and that there was approximately 15 to 20 people at the party. He stated that he did not know any of the people at the party and that he had only seen some of them occasionally before. He stated that there was a blue & white GMC pickup parked at the party with two kegs of beer setting in the bed of the truck. Pierce stated that between 9:30 PM and 10:00 PM he saw an orange Pinto pull up to the party and that a couple of people went over to the car. He stated that he saw the blonde haired girl who he believed to be Raylene Rice get out of the car and that she had been talking to some of the subjects that had came over to the car. He stated that there was two females sitting in the front seat who he believed to be Raylene Rice and the dark headed girl whom he believed to be Jill Montgomery and he stated that there was two to three males in the back seat. He stated that one of the males was a black male who seemed to be very tall and skinny and had a short afro and a sloppy flannel shirt. He stated that he believed the black male to be between the ages of 19 to 20 years old. Pierce also stated that there was a dark blue GMC van with a silver stripe at the party and that the people occupying the van had stated that they were going to stay in Speegleville all night long. He stated that the orange Pinto left the party after approximately 20 minutes and that they had driven off and then returned to the party approximately one half hour later. He stated that several other people then went to the car AGAIN and that he believed that possibly the people in the orange Pinto were selling Marijuana. He then stated that the orange Pinto left for a second time and approximately one half hour later after the orange Pinto left that everyone else decided to leave as it was getting close to 11:00 PM and that the front gate to Speegleville was going to close. once again, for more details. At 4:00 P.M., 7-19-82, I received a phone call from BETTY DODD of 1013 Church, phone number 754-6438. She informed me that she was riding around with ELIZABETH MORAN on Monday, 7-12-82. She stated that she and ELIZABETH both saw KEN, JILL & RAYLENE leave their orange Pinto in KOEHE PARK, and get into a black TRANS AM, with the front license plate of USA 1, at approximately 11:30 to 11:45 P.M., on 7-12-82. She stated that JILL got into the front seat, and that the other two subjects got into the back seat. She stated that the black TRANS AM then drove off. She described the driver as being a white male, 23 or 25 years of age, with shoulder length hair, and a white shirt. DODD stated that 'she and ELIZABETH both knew KEN, and recognized the other two girls in the Pinto, from the paper. She stated that she was absolutely positive that it was Monday night that this occurred. I am not too sure about the facts that BETTY DODD had related to us, because of the fact that RAYLENE and JILL were not even supposed to have left WAXAHACHE until Tuesday morning, 7-13-82. So it is possible that BETTY DODD has Monday and Tuesday mixed up. After Detective SALINAS had been talking with REBECCA DES MARIAS, she had informed him that she had not talked to TAB HUNTER until sometime between 8:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M., on 7-14-82, and that was when he was asking her about this information. We were unsure as to what time the radios had broadcast the information about the triple murder in SPEEGLEVILLE, so myself and Sgt. HOLSTIEN called all the RADIO STATIONS to find out when they first broadcast this information. I called Radio Station K-95 and talked to BOB LOTT; KHR, and talked to RICK BAILEY; KHOO, and talked to JODIE HAYS; KKIK, and talked to DAN TEMPLES. I also called the TEXAS STATE NEWS NETWORK, and talked to Mr. METZGER. After calling all of these RADIO STATIONS, between 4:30 P.M. and 5:00 P.M., the earliest broadcast was from KKIK, and they stated that they first broadcast the information between 9:15 P.M. and 9:30 P.M., 7-14-82, and then broadcast it again at 10:05 P.M. RADIO STATION K-95 stated that they did not broadcast it until 7:30 A.M., 7-15-82. TEXAS STATE NEWS NETWORK stated that they did not release their information to our local radio stations, until 10:55 P.M., 7-14-82. Mr. METZGER can be reached at the TEXAS STATE NEWS NETWORK at phone number (214) 688-1133, in the News Department. The earliest time that Sgt. HOLSTIEN had found out from anyone, was at 9:45 P.M., out of the Radio Stations that he called. Out of all the Radio Stations in Waco that may have broadcast this information on 7-14-82, KKIK broadcast the earliest information, and that was between 9:15 P.M. and 9:30 P.M. I received a phone call from BOBBY BREM at 5:30 P.M., 7-19-82, phone 752-9346, and he informed me that he was talking
