I, Henry Lee Lucas, have been first duly warned by

Sheriff's Office in Montague, Texas, of the following rights:

1. I have the right to remain silent and not make any statement at all and that any statement I make may be used against me at my trial;
2. Any statement I make may be used as evidence against me in court;
3. I have the right to have a lawyer present to advise me prior to and during any questioning;
4. If I am unable to employ a lawyer, I have the right to have a lawyer appointed to advise me prior to and during any questioning; and
5. I have the right to terminate the interview at any time.

I have read the above rights and have had the same explained to me and do knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily waive the rights as set out above. I do hereby freely and voluntarily, without being induced by any compulsion, threats, promises or persuasion, make the following statement in writing:

My name is Henry Lee Lucas and I am 46 years of age;

In 1979, (I am not sure of the time of year, I picked up a girl who was hitchhiking in Oklahoma City, about the second exit off a turnpike. It could have been in one of three cars I had. I think her name was Joanie or Judy - I don't remember exactly. We stopped at a truck stop and ate - I don't recall if she had a hamburger or plate lunch I was drinking beer. I had sexual intercourse with her at a roadside park or picnic area. I think she was wearing something I don't know if it was a ketex or what. I didn't get satisfied I don't know if something was wrong with her or something wrong with me. I killed her not long after that by strangling her with my hands. She was later undressed, and I had sex with her after she was dead. She was in the back seat lying down. I still couldn't come - something was wrong with either her or me, I don't recall what. She didn't feel right. I drug her out of my car somewhere on 1435, southbound toward San Antonio, and dropped her into a culvert. I remember an iron guard rail with curved iron, because I skinned my knee on it.

I further affirm that I knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily waived the above rights prior to and during the making of this statement.
