This officer received a call to speak to an informant out at Plantation Foods at 3130 Gholson Road. I spoke to a white male Butler, Nathan Dale, home address is P. O. Box 215, Rosebud, live on Linden Road, employed at Plantation Foods, business phone 799-6211, ext: 226. Subject works between the hours of 4:00 PM and 12:00 midnight.

Nathan advised me that he thought that he may have some information concerning the murder that had taken place out at Speegleville Park, Wednesday, 7-14-82. He stated that he had gotten off work at approximately 2:00 AM Wednesday morning, 7-15-82, and had taken one of his friends home who lives in Robinson. He stated that he had dropped his friend off and proceeded to drive to Rosebud where he lives down Hwy 77. He stated that at approximately 5:00 AM about three or four miles outside of Robinson going toward Rosebud he had observed a black male walking along the highway. He stopped and asked the man where he was going and the black male stated to him that he was going to Caldwell. Nathan advised him at this time that he did not know where Caldwell was that he was only going as far as Rosebud and that he would take him that far. The black male then agreed and got into the vehicle with him.

Nathan stated that the black male that he had picked up was approximately 6' to 6'1" weighing 165 to 170 lbs, between the ages of 35 and 45, wearing blue jeans with a red & dark blue plaid shirt, long sleeves, also wearing a black ball cap with no wording on it. The black male also had a short afro with beard and spots of gray hair in the beard. He thinks that the mans name was William however he could not remember exactly. The black male did give him his last name but he could not remember what it was. Nathan said that as he saw the black male walking down 77 he appeared to stagger a little bit. He also stated that after he picked him up and got him in the car he appeared to have been drinking some. He also acted extremely nervous and kept looking back over his shoulder. Nathan said that as the black male got into the vehicle when the dome light of his car came on he observed a spot of blood on his left pants leg approximately at the knee. He stated that the blood spot was approximately two inches in diameter and also around it were several spots of blood that appeared to have dropped on him. Nathan stated that he knew this was blood because of the fact that he works at Plantation Foods he sees people get their hands cut several times and he can observe what the blood on clothing does look like.

The black male also while sitting in the car appeared to be extremely nervous and he kept reach

ing down his right leg as though he was reaching down into his boot. Nathan thought that maybe he had a gun or knife and he was becoming extremely scared of having picked the black male up.

After he picked the black male up Nathan said that in order to have some kind of conversation with the man he asked him where he was coming from. He then stated that the black male had told him that he had been out out at Lake Waco and Speegleville Park and that was the end of it. Nathan stated that the black male was not volunteering to come in to a conversation. The extent of the conversation was to the point where Nathan was asking questions and the black male was answering them. The black male while riding with Nathan kept looking out the passenger window. He could not tell whether the black male was looking behind him or just looking out to the side however he appeared to be very, very nervous and in some what of a hurry to get out of the Waco area. Nathan stated that the black male did not appear to be injured so he thought that the blood on the man may have come from somebody else. Nathan stated that the drive to Rosebud is approximately 25 to 30 minutes long and the black male did not say too much during the ride other than answer his questions. Nathan stated that he would be glad to speak to our detectives at anytime if they wanted too. He could be contacted at Plantation Foods where he is employed. He does not have a home phone.
