Patricia met James Bishop in 1977. They were married in Germany in 1979.

Patricia said that their sex life was normal, there was no bondage or sadistic tendencies. It should be noted that during the interview with Patricia, her mother was present and would leave the room.

Both Madelyn and Patricia said that James had a drinking problem. James would go out in the evening and night and drink with the guys.

James did always have guns around him and would constantly play with them. James did shoot himself while they were stationed in Germany. Both Madelyn and Patricia were present at the time that James shot himself. They both said that James had been out drinking and had come home intoxicated. Madelyn and Patricia were reading and according to them that seemed to perturb James. James went to his room and shoot himself in the left shoulder. Madelyn and Patricia said that it appeared that James was trying to get some attention. According to statements made by Terry Smith and Susan Manes, James was shot in a narcotic raid.

Patricia was aware of previous marriage of James, to Brenda. She believed that the reason for divorce was because Brenda did not like the military life.

Just before Christmas of 1981, Patricia was told by James that he wanted a divorce. She does not know the reason that James wanted the divorce. She left Waco shortly there after and arrived in San Diego to live with her mother on or about 1-4-82.

Neither the mother nor Patricia knew the exact date that James showed up in San Diego but believed it to be around the 1st. of August 1982.

James did live with Madelyn and Patricia at 3203 Via Tonga for 2 to 3 months before moving to Sunburst House where he was employed as a maintenance man. He moved in the Sunburst House in November of 1982.

When James arrived in California he told both Madelyn and Patricia not to let anyone in Waco know where he was. As far as they were concerned he was in Virginia.
